The Ontario Pork Congress is in active mode again in 2012. The enclosed brochures outline the Classes as well as the prize money.

Please note that the Pig Art Scholarship is once again introduced to the college/university and Grade 12 students planning to attend a post-secondary school in the fall. This \$250 scholarship is intended to assist a student currently enrolled in Grade 12 and registered for further education or a student enrolled in university or college. Criteria include an agricultural background, interest in pursuing further education in fine art and demonstrated community involvement.

Categories and prices are detailed in the Pig Art brochure and we have included an application form in the brochure. Remember to let us know if you do not want your art to be sold and the drop off location for the art pieces is at the Stratford Agriplex – Ontario Pork Congress Office – between 9 AM and 1 PM on Monday June 18, 2012. This year, we are continuing with the Digital Photography Class. This Class includes two divisions: (a) photos within the barn and (b) photos outside of the barn. Prize money has been increased for this Class at:

- 1st - \$100; 2nd - \$50 and 3rd - \$25. So get out your cameras – and send us your pictures!
