1. Completed entry forms and exhibits must be received on or before June 18, 2012
2. All entries must include a completed entry form firmly attached.
3. Entries may be addressed and sent to: Lori Moser, Ontario Pork Congress PO Box 23050 Stratford, Ontario N5A 7V8. Or dropped off at the Ontario Pork Congress Office at the Stratford Rotary Complex between 9 AM & 1 PM on June 18, 2012. Judging will take place at 2 PM on Monday June 18, 2012. Decisions of the judges are final.
4. All entries must be pork/pig related
5. All entries must be the original product of the entry
6. All photographs submitted will be considered the property of Ontario Pork Congress and may be used by OPC for promotions.
7. Fine art entries may be framed or mounted at the artist's discretion. Please provide some means for hanging for display.
8. Owners will assume all risk and should any article be accidentally injured, marred, lost, stolen or destroyed, the Directors of OPC will not be held responsible and will not provide payment for the value or any portion thereof.
9. The OPC Directors reserve the right to reject or accept applications at any time.
10. All entries may be sold at an auction unless otherwise specified by the entrant. Any article not sold must be picked up by the entrant on Wednesday June 20th by 5 PM.
11. People's Choice Awards are available. Ballots will be available at the Pig Art display during the Congress. Winners will be announced at the OPC and names will be published.
